
Top Colleges with Early Decision 2 (ED2)

Early Decision 2 is a second-round opportunity to apply to a top-choice college with a binding commitment: you are agreeing to attend if they admit you. ED2 deadlines typically occur in January, which means if you do not get into your first choice college in the ED1 round (apply in the fall, hear in December), you have the option to commit to a second choice college for ED2.
